The Glacier Symphony and Chorale and the League of Glacier Symphony & Chorale are pleased to announce the 2010 Scholarship Program for Young Musicians.

Following are the requirements that must be met to be eligible:

The Glacier Symphony and Chorale will accept applications for a limited number of scholarships from students who have played with the Glacier Symphony for at least 3 concerts during a regular season or who are on the permanent orchestra substitution list, or those who have sung in the Glacier Chorale. In addition, when funds are available, "at-large" scholarships may be provided to outstanding music students who show exceptional ability, but have not yet had the opportunity to perform with the GSC. Scholarships must be used for students to further their musical careers through camps, private lessons, or college tuition. Those eligible can be from 9th to 12th grades, including seniors who are graduating.

The purposes of the scholarships are to encourage student participation in the Glacier Symphony and Chorale, and to assist those musicians in pursuing musical careers or an avocation in music. The award of scholarships will be based on musical ability and potential as determined by the Scholarship Committee.

The recipients will be announced at our April, 2010 concert, and the Graduating Senior Awards will be presented at the student's high school spring award assembly. Funds will not be distributed directly to the recipients, but will be sent to the private music teacher, music camp, or institution indicated in the application materials. Proof of attendance will be required.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM AND APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Purpose: The GSC and the League of the GSC have established this scholarship program to encourage young musicians who play with the Glacier Orchestra or sing with the Glacier Chorale to pursue their education in music or to invest their time and energy in improving their musicianship.

Eligibility: The Glacier Symphony and Chorale will accept applications for a limited number of scholarships from students who have played with the Glacier Symphony for at least 3 concerts during a regular season or who are on the permanent orchestra substitution list, or those who have sung in the Glacier Chorale. In addition, when funds are available, "at-large" scholarships may be provided to outstanding music students who show exceptional ability, but have not yet had the opportunity to perform with the GSC. Scholarships must be used for students to further their musical careers through camps, private lessons, or college tuition. Those eligible can be from 9th to 12th grades, including seniors who are graduating.

Scholarship Amounts: It is anticipated that individual scholarships will be in the range of \$250 to \$1000.

If lessons are discontinued, camp not attended, or if the college award winners were to decide not to go to college, the remaining funds are to be returned so another student may benefit from the scholarship program in the future.

- 3. Tape or CD marked with applicant's name and name of piece(s) being performed (not to exceed 10 minutes)**
- 4. Music Teacher Reference Form**
